Aren't some children being left behind?

This is of course why we want to get all children back to school as soon as it is safe to do so.

While many parents can and do support their children very well with home (or 'remote') learning, other parents will find this a struggle: you are not teachers and do not have the space and resources we have at school. We appreciate that no amount of resources we suggest or timetables we provide can replace the impact of actually being in school.

The children who have been attending our provision have not, however, had any favouritism, or been given one to one schooling. The purpose of our provision has been largely (very high quality) child care, ensuring both safety in a happy, healthy environment.

All the home learning materials and ideas we have provided are adapted to suit a range of interests and approaches. We keep emphasising the message that they are not compulsory – it is far, far more important that your child is both happy and safe.
