By implementing the full range of measures in guidance

Assessment, we believe so.

We will be strongly following the five key steps:

- Minimising contact with anyone who is unwell by ensuring no-one with symptoms of the virus comes to school
- Washing hands well, with soap and warm water, and more often than normal
- Practising good respiratory hygiene (catch it, bin it, kill it)
- Minimising contacts between groups of children, and
- Making sure our cleaning of frequently touched surfaces is thorough and frequent.

Government would not allow the return to school if the scientific advice did not indicate it was safe to do so.
