Y6 Visit to The National Holocaust Centre Wednesday 3rd October

Dear Parent/Carer,

As you may already be aware, our first educational visit of the year is to the National Holocaust Centre in Newark. This supports our topic 'The Second World War through different eyes.' Through this visit the children will gain an awareness and understanding of the choices made by individuals and how those choices shaped the lives of Jewish children during World War II. The cost for this visit is **£15** which includes coach travel to and from the centre.

To cover the costs for this trip, we are asking for a contribution per child. As with all activities of this kind, we can only ask for a voluntary contribution, but should insufficient funds be received, the event may have to be cancelled. All payments should be made through sQuid.

Please note the coaches have been booked to arrive before the start of the school day so that we can ensure prompt arrival at the centre.

All children will need to be in their classes ready for registration at 8.15am.

Our session ends at 2.00pm so we envisage a late return too.

We should arrive back at school approximately 3.30pm

Please ensure your child knows the going home arrangements for that day.

All children will need a packed lunch and a mid morning snack. Everyone should wear school uniform for the visit and there will be an opportunity to visit the museum shop – suggested amount is £3.

As always, we would very much welcome parent volunteers to help on the day. If you are able to come along, please fill in the form below and hand back to your class teacher. Unfortunately, we can only take 2 parents per class so in the event of lots of you coming forward, we will draw names out of a hat!
