## Aren't some children being left behind?

We want to get all children back to school as soon as it is safe to do so.

While many parents can and do support their children very well with home (or 'remote') learning, other parents will find this a struggle: you are not teachers and do not have the space and resources we have at school. We appreciate that no amount of resources we suggest or timetables we provide can replace the impact of actually being in school. We are therefore delivering home learning daily (via Zoom) by a member of teaching staff to all pupils, regardless of whether pupils are in school or learning from home. The work accessed at home will be the same as the work being carried out in school.

There will be two Zoom sessions each day, one in the morning to explain the day's work and another later in the day to catch up.
