

Home, blended or remote Learning due to Covid19

From Monday 8 March we have welcomed back all children to school. Although school attendance is mandatory there may be some circumstances where pupils cannot attend school due to coronavirus (COVID-19). Where this is the case home, blended or remote learning will be put in place as follows:

- **If a pupil is not able to attend for a short period of time whilst they are awaiting a test, but following a negative result are subsequently able to return to school**

Or

- **A pupil is not able to attend school due to a positive test in the household (resulting in isolation and being absent for at least 10 / 14 days).**
