Dear Year 4 Parents/Carers,

As you may already be aware, our topic this term has centred around habitats. To enhance and enrich our learning further, we have booked a half-day visit for each class to Grenoside Woods in Sheffield. At the centre, the children will be able to study a host of different animals looking at their behaviour and food choices and also take part in some pond dipping. The four sessions will be led by a member of the Outdoor Education team at the woods. There are two dates for the visits:

**Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> April - Y4S/S (morning) & Y4JP (afternoon)**

**Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> April - Y4JD (morning) & Y4CW (afternoon)**

The morning sessions (Y4S/S and Y4JD) will leave school at 8.50am and return to school for lunch. We ask that they have a packed lunch on the day just in case the coach is held up for any reason and they miss the year group sitting. The afternoon sessions (Y4JP and Y4CW) will be leaving school at around 12pm, having eaten a packed lunch beforehand in their classrooms and will then return to school in time for the end of the school day.

The children should wear normal school uniform on the day but please also make sure that your child has a waterproof outdoor coat and some wellies or suitable footwear as all of our time will be spent outdoors. Your child will also need a snack and a water bottle.

The cost for this visit is **£11.00**. This includes the cost of the workshop and coach travel to and from Grenoside.

*To cover the costs for this trip, we are asking for a contribution per child. As with all activities of this kind, we can only ask for a voluntary contribution, but should insufficient funds be received, the event may have to be cancelled. All payments should be made through Parentpay.*

**PLEASE NOTE THAT Y4S/S & Y4JD WILL TO BE IN SCHOOL AT 8.35am ON THEIR DAY AS WE NEED TO MAKE A PROMPT START FOR THE WORKSHOPS.**
