Gates and School Timings

Thank you for everyone's support helping to get their children to school on time. The Y3 gate on Tapton field and the main top gate on Manchester Road will be open at 8.35am and closed at 8.50am. The school bell goes at 8.45am, which is the start of school and lessons. We really want the children to start learning swiftly in the morning. We will have the Shore Lane gate open for the morning clubs and Lexia learning, but this gate will be shut by 8.35am, so please use the top gate after that. If you arrive later than 8.50am or need to come to school during the school day please use the Shore Lane gate (press the buzzer) and go to the School Office.

Requests for Exceptional Leave

As I am sure you appreciate, regular school attendance is essential if pupils are to maximise their educational opportunities. The Local Authority and Lydgate Junior School have a responsibility to provide the best education possible but we can only do this if pupils attend regularly. Taking time out of school for holidays can be disruptive; it can also be difficult for pupils to catch up on work missed.

The Headteacher may only consider giving permission for a pupil to be absent from school in term time in 'exceptional circumstances' and proof will be requested by the Headteacher.

Requests for exceptional leave should be made at least 14 days in advance. We understand this is not always possible, but please note **we are unable to authorise absence retrospectively**.
