Dear Parent/Carer,

To start our new history topic about life in the Stone Age, the children in Y3 will be taking part in an outdoor forest schools lesson. This session will be run by Foresteers and will last for half a day for each class.

The sessions will take place on the following days:

Wednesday 10th December – Mayfly & Diving Beetle Thursday 11th December – Grasshopper & Pond Skater

We will be going outside whatever the weather so the children will need to wrap up warm (lots of layers is ideal as it is likely to be cold) and they will need suitable footwear to change into. They will stop for a drink of hot chocolate during the lesson to help keep them warm.

Please let the school office know if your child is unable to have hot chocolate due to allergies.

On the day, please send to school:

- A **change** of footwear wellies, walking boots or old trainers are ideal (we will ask the children to change into their indoor shoes when they come into the school building)
- A warm waterproof coat, hat and gloves these may get muddy
- Lots of layers of clothing to keep them warm
- A plastic bag to carry their muddy shoes home in
- A mug for their hot chocolate

In order to go ahead with this event, we need to ask for a contribution of £7.50 per child. As with all activities of this kind, we can only ask for a voluntary contribution, but should insufficient funds be received, the event may have to be cancelled. Payments can be made via ParentPay.
