As part of our topic on **The Romans**, we have arranged for Past Productions to run a day's workshop for each class. The children will take part in activities around crime and punishment, Roman inventions, the Roman army and different gods. They will also have the opportunity to handle artefacts and take part in a big quiz at the end of the day.

These workshops will take place on the following dates:

We have also booked an exciting outdoor 'Roman Invader' day at Mount Cook in Derbyshire. We will immerse ourselves in the time period by meeting a Roman soldier and trying on his armour, taking part in a military drill, practising archery and building land karts.

The Mount Cook Roman Invader days will take place on the following dates:

Tuesday 22nd November - 4JP and 4SW

While we are committed to enhancing the curriculum with rich opportunities for our children, we do understand that we are in the middle of a cost of living crisis. This is why we are letting you know about our Y4 experiences for the whole of the Autumn term.
