Dear Parent/Carer

You are already aware that, as part of our study of contrasting localities, we are taking the Y4 children to Scarborough for the day. **This will take place on Wednesday 26th June 2024.** Over the course of the day, we will be visiting the castle, taking part in fieldwork and we will of course be spending some time on the beach. There may even be an ice cream thrown in!

In order to make the most of the day, we need to leave school early and we will arrive back late. **We ask that the children be in school by 7:15am to register and we aim to arrive back at school at 7.30pm.**

Everyone should wear school uniform for the day. Please also make sure that your child is dressed appropriately for the weather. It is likely to be warm and sunny so we ask that all children have a hat and that sun cream has already been applied - staff will carry extra sun cream. As we know, the weather at the seaside can be unpredictable so a raincoat would be a good idea too! Your child will also need a small towel and spare clothes in case we go paddling, as well as a packed lunch and a water bottle. As it is such a long day, you may want to send a couple of extra snacks. There is no need for pocket money as ice cream will be included as part of the visit.

The cost for this visit is **£27.00** which includes coach travel, the visit to the castle and an ice cream. *All payments should be made through ParentPay.*
