Y5 Sikh Gurdwara (Temple) Trip – Wednesday 15th October

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of their RE work on Sikhism, Year 5 pupils will be visiting the Sikh Gurdwara (Temple) near Meadowhall on Wednesday 15th October. We will travel by coach and classes will attend at the following times:

Goldfinch & Wren will leave school at 9am and will return during lunchtime.

Robin & Nuthatch will leave school at 11am and will return around 2pm.

All children (both boys and girls) will be required to wear a **head-covering - a scarf or bandana (not hats)** - that covers their heads. This is required to show respect inside the Gurdwara.

All children need to bring a **vegetarian packed lunch** (no egg or nuts) on the day as they will be eating their lunch inside the Gurdwara building.

The children will be offered a snack and a drink inside the main building which is part of the Sikhism tradition of sharing food.

We are grateful to Mrs Kaur for giving us this opportunity and organising the trip for us.

We would appreciate one parent volunteer per class to accompany us on this visit. If you can spare a few hours, please email enquiries@lydgate-jun.sheffield.sch.uk as soon as possible to let us know.

The cost of the coach will be **£5.75** per child and payment should be made, as usual, through ParentPay. As with all activities of this kind, we can only ask for a voluntary contribution, but should insufficient funds be received, the event may have to be cancelled. We realise that this is a second paid trip within the same half term but it is a fantastic opportunity to enrich the children's learning.
